Ditch along hedge on playing field	Overgrown and requires cleaning out	Will be cleaned by Councillors
Ditch on fence line of playing field	Overgrown.	Clerk to obtain quotation for selective vegetation removal – can only be done in August
Football posts	Nets missing	Clerk to purchase two new nets.
Football posts	Rusting arms to goal posts	Rust repair onto goal posts
BT junction box	Collapse of tarmac	Clerk to follow up with WLDC
Playground	Gap in fence on Sunnyside driveway	Clerk to source a quotation to replace fencing
Playground	Gap in fence on A46	Clerk to source a quotation to replace fencing
Monument to Fallen		Clerk to contact Kisimul to find out who the contractor is and extend contract to cover monument
Fence along permissible path	Falling over into pathway	Clerk to follow up with WLDC/ LCC
